

Funding

In autumn 2012, the Government announced a Year 7 Catch-up Premium. £500 has been allocated for each pupil who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or mathematics (maximum £500 per pupil) at Key Stage 2. In January 2013, £19,000 was received for the year 7 catch up grant.

During 2012/13, Year 7 Catch Up funding was used by North Leamington School to employ 1:1 tutors to enable all students to who achieved below Level 4 in KS2 SATs in English or Maths to have access to additional 1:1 or small group work in English or Maths.

Outcomes

Maths: 25 students achieved KS2 SATs levels below Level 4 (6 of them below Level 3). At the end of Year 7, 12 of these students were working above Level 4 and 6 above level 5.

English: 21 students achieved KS2 SATs levels below Level 4 (5 below Level 3). At the end of Year 7, 13 of these students were working above Level 4.
